Opening Cocktail

The Hôtel de Ville de Lyon is the city hall and one of the largest historic buildings in the city, located between the Place des Terreaux and the Place de la Comédie, in front of the Nouvel Opera House. Since 12 July 1886, the building has been classified as a Monument historique.



Gala Dinner

This cruise on the Saône river is one of the best way to see Lyon (UNESCO World Heritage city) and its beauties, all the while enjoying a nice dinner on the boat. The boat cruises along the « Vieux Lyon » area where you can admire Lyon's architectural heritage.



Tours

Lyon - Fourvière

The esplanade of Fourvière offers a magnificent uninterrupted view of Lyon. The discovery of the basilica, one of the symbols of the city, immerses you in the late 19th century. Don't walk by without taking a look inside, because the interior is just as remarkable as the outside.



Old Lyon and its Traboules

This first discovery tour of the Vieux-Lyon area invites you to walk through the cobbled alleyways of the Saint Jean area, via its internal courtyards (traboules), to discover the atmosphere which is very characteristic. Urbanized as early as the Middle Ages, the area now boasts 24 hectares of buildings mainly dating back to the 15th and 16th century, combining Gothic and Renaissance architecture. Go back to the times of the great fairs that secured the wealth and celebrity of the city and relive the history of leading local and Italian families who left their mark here.

Your guide will reveal secrets and anecdotes that have made the reputation of this historic area, which is the first area in France to have been preserved and inscribed on UNESCO's



Museums

Confluences Museum

Situated on the confluence of the Rhône and the Saône, the Musée des Confluences is an absolute must-see in Lyon. Set in the heart of a monumental structure of metal and glass, the Musée des Confluences presents a journey through time and across continents to observe the world around us and tells the story of mankind and the history of life.



Lugdunum

The Gallo-Roman Museum of Lyon and the archaeological site (integrated into the perimeter classified World Heritage by Unesco) are situated on the slopes of the Fourvière hill, formerly in the centre of the Roman City of Lugdunum, founded in 43 B.C.



Museum of Fine Arts of Lyon

Musée des beaux-arts de Lyon is located near Place des Terreaux and housed in a former Benedictine convent which was active during the 17th and 18th centuries. Its collections range from ancient Egyptian antiquities to the Modern art period, making the museum one of the most important in Europe.
